- -We have focused more on K-2 reading, so county wide we are working on upper grades help.
- -In Feb we had a teacher PD on writing and incorporating more writing to get students ready for Milestones.
- -Nancy said our students need more practice with typing, Kaylin is working on typing in the computer lab
- -iReady really raised the bar and rigger for our students reading
- -After school tutoring- we purchased coach books and the teachers are going page by page during this time. There are 20 students per grade level- 2 teachers (10 students per teacher). There is a teacher guide that is step by step. This is truly test prep. The success of this progress

will be judged by the growth expectation. Parents are already very pleased with the after school tutoring program.
